Get Your Tax Refund Faster with Direct Deposit

Expecting a tax refund this year? The IRS recommends filing electronically and using Direct Deposit to receive your refund faster and more securely.



With Direct Deposit, your refund goes straight into your LPCCU checking or savings account—no paper checks, no unnecessary delays.

What you'll need when filing:

- LPCCU routing & transit number: **2724-82375**
- Your **5-digit account number**
- Choose **checking or savings**

Important reminder:

The refund must be deposited into an account with your name on it. Deposits sent to an account you don't own may be rejected and delay your refund.
